

## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Thank you for your letter of 24 July 2008 in which you requested the following information:

- When were the Cabinet Office first contacted by BT/Phorm to discuss internet advertising?
- What correspondence has been exchanged concerning internet advertising between the Cabinet Office and BT, and the Cabinet Office and Phorm since 2006?
- When has the Prime Minister/Cabinet met with BT/Phorm to discuss internet advertising, what were the dates, minutes and agenda of those meetings?
- When were the Cabinet first made aware of the trials of Phorm systems in 2006/2007?
- What evidence has the Prime Minister/Cabinet Office sought from BT concerning the secret trials in 2006/2007?
- When was Rt. Hon Gordon Brown MP first advised that covert trials of Phorm/121Media systems had been conducted in 2006/2007?
- What action has the Prime Minister taken as a consequence?

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, we have established that the Cabinet Office does not hold information relevant to your request.
